The least expensive way to get LoggerNet 4.2 is with the LoggerNet/U (P/N 16347) which is an upgrade to the current version. And even though it's an "upgrade", the software you'll receive will be the full version. Educational pricing is \$312 and I've attached a quote with the part number.

A customer qualifies for the LoggerNet upgrade either by owning (1) PC400 or (2) a previous version of LoggerNet. So you will have the option of using either the PC400 you just purchased or the LoggerNet 2.1 you previously owned as the piece of software you're upgrading to fulfill this portion of the license agreement:

"(3) If this copy of the software is an upgrade from a previous version, you must possess a valid license for the earlier version of software. You may continue to use the earlier copy of software only if the upgrade copy and earlier version are installed and used on the same computer. The earlier version of software may not be installed and used on a separate computer or transferred to another party."
